Attendees and Apologies

Kings Highway to Discovery

John Sandow welcomed Tracey Lamont to the meeting and apologised for the lack of attendees.

The Kings Highway to Discovery project is now well advanced with only 5 months left to run. Tracey outlined the overall progress and focused especially on those facets still to be completed and their relevance to Captains Flat. The website is designed around 7 themes, within which specific town attractions are either embedded or linked. Captains Flat attractions and links now occur in most themes but there are opportunities for further additions. The most urgent issue now is the implementation of signage. Funds deriving from the Kings Highway project and Council allocations will be combined to design, manufacture and erect the many new signs that are a part of the program. This includes a large number of "locality" signs (including entry signs for towns) and information panels within towns providing a locality map, pictures and historical notes. It is intended that all signage will be themed with the Kings Highway branding along with Palerang and Commonwealth Government logos. Tracey provided an example of the information panel (for Araluen; attached to this email FYI). The draft design of the locality signs is still being prepared and must comply with RTA requirements. The locality sign for Captains Flat will be in addition to, and complementary to, the existing welcome sign and will help identify Captains Flat as being an integral component of the Kings Highway to Discovery initiative.

An appropriate location for the larger information panel for Captains Flat will need to be agreed and forwarded to Tracey for subsequent Council ratification. Two alternate locations should also be considered in the event Council has any misgivings.

Actions:

1. Tracey will forward the proposed design of the Captains Flat locality sign when the draft is ready.
2. JS to circulate the draft of the information panel to Committee members and organise a discussion and decision regarding its placement.
3. JS to draft an article for CFT to advise local residents of some recent Community Association activities and including information on the Kings Highway to Discovery project, the website and the new signage.

Owing to the lack of quorum, no other agenda items were addressed.
